



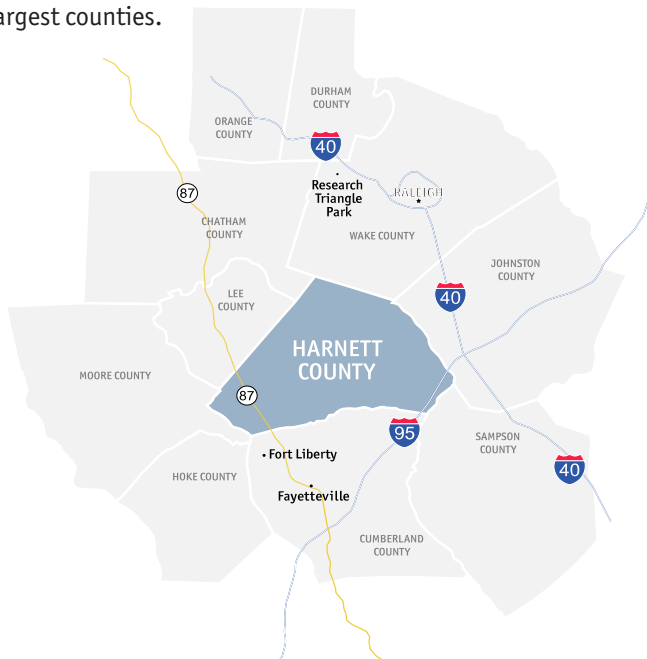

Harnett County is a dynamic and fast-growing region in central North Carolina, strategically positioned between Raleigh and the Research Triangle to the north, and Fayetteville and Fort Bragg to the south. Located along the I-95 Corridor, Harnett County offers access to major transportation networks, railways, and airports. 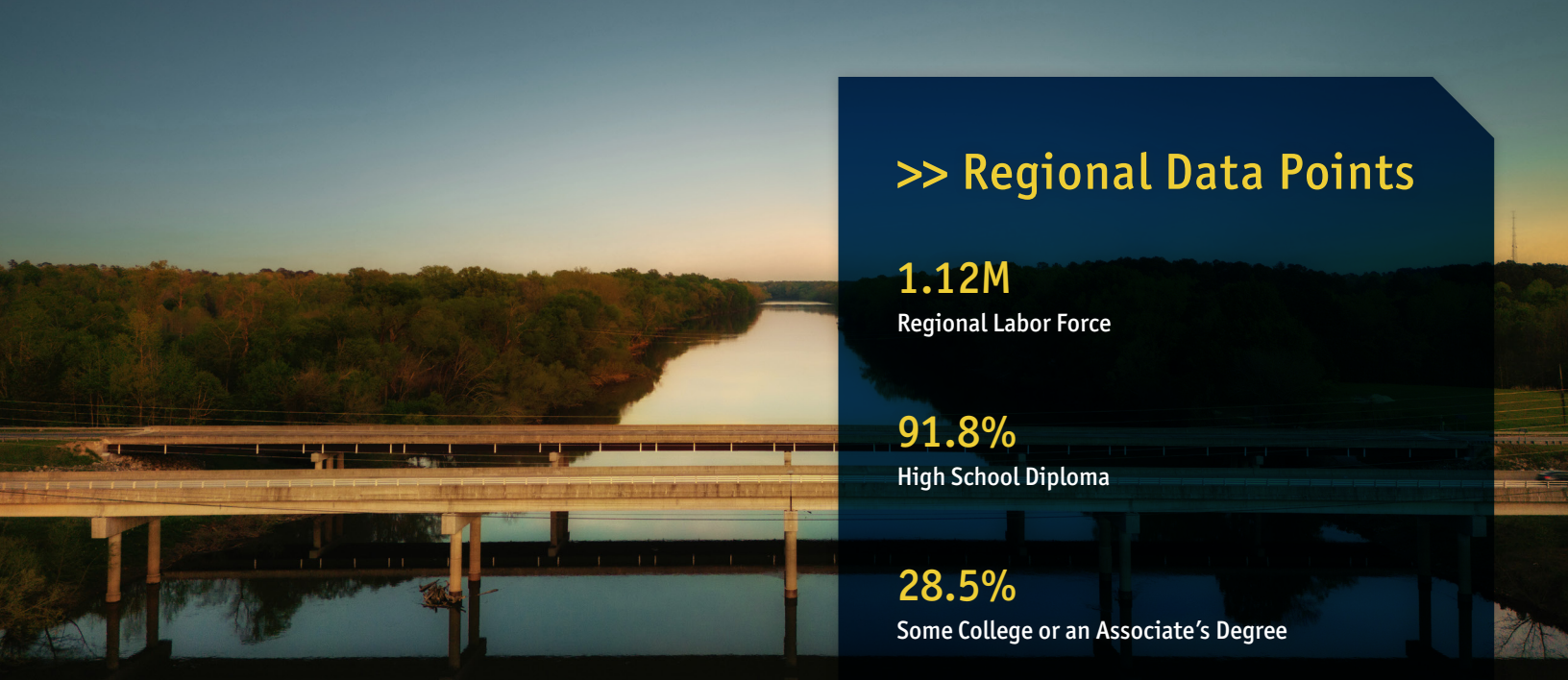
